

Wrapping up the end of the year seems unbelievable! Senior class of 2023, as per the google classroom and also your email, please make sure that all scholarships that you have received have been emailed to Mrs. Brunz at <u>cathy.brunz@spssailors.org</u>.

There are a few things to be aware of going into the summer. First of all, future freshman through seniors have already registered for the 2023-2024 school year. Before they check out for the summer, they will hopefully get to see their schedule and make any changes. Dual Credit registration should already be turned into the college, but if your student has not completed this task yet, please have them get this in before summer break. The next ACT is June 10th and one must register at <u>www.actstudent.org</u> by May 5th to avoid a late fee. If you have a 2024 senior, tasks that could be completed over the summer are college visits, narrowing down their list of colleges to 5 or under, making a resume', and thinking about which teachers, employers, etc that might possibly write them letters of recommendations in the fall. If your student took any classes through MPCC, please make sure they have requested their official transcripts to be sent to their college of choice so they get everything transferred.

When the class of 2024 returns in the fall, they will receive a folder with all information they need for senior year. This folder will discuss timelines of when scholarships are due, when they can fill out the FAFSA, when to apply to college, and everything in between so stay tuned to this.
